Share Outs	 Judy Dunne - Census 2020 Judy presented about the 2020 census and how important it is to respond. Pacific County is among the lowest in the US with response rates. The data collected from the Census determines how much federal dollars we will get for the next 10 years. All of the data collected is safe and secure. Darian Johnson - Youth Homelessness Demonstration Project (YHDP) The YHDP program provides homeless youth and young adults with assistance and housing. Pacific County has two different programs within YHDP; Supportive Services Only and Rapid Rehousing. In order to be eligible for the Supportive Services Only program, youth need to be 16 - 18 years old and living with natural supports. Youth on this program get a food allowance to help offset additional food costs for the program. To be eligible for the Rapid Rehousing program, young adults need to be 18 - 24 years old and have a criminal record. This program provides rental assistance and case management. Young adults MUST go through coordinated entry at CCAP in order to access the RRH program.
